ABOUT THE PROJECT



The "Key of Return" is a symbol for the desire of Palestinian refugees to return, which is demonstratively hung above the entrance of the refugee camp Aida in Bethlehem above the heads of the people who want to enter the refugee camp. The "Key of Return" symbolizes the loss of homeland of refugees regardless of their origin and points out that for many refugees a return to their home country often remains an unfulfilled wish and that integration creates perspective for togetherness and cohesion from the perspective of the host country and the refugees, in a time marked by demographic, cultural, social, economic and political change.

The intercultural DAAD project "Organizational Development and Social Work with Refugees", which runs from January to December 2020, aims to implement practical projects in Jordan, Palestine and Germany. These deal with the question under which educational, organizational, social (especially media) conditions refugees can be integrated. Students, lecturers and actors in civil society, humanitarian aid and welfare jointly develop, present and evaluate practical projects. Various activities and workshops were planned to introduce this topic. The kick-off event has the goal that all students and professors participating in the intercultural project get to know each other. Various student working groups will present their practical projects that they have developed within the DAAD project. Afterwards they will be discussed. In a second step, the students work out to what extent which parts of the projects can be compared. On December 10th, a second meeting will take place in which the students will present the progress of their work on the practical projects and compare the project parts defined during the first meeting with each other.














INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE REGISTRATION IN THE PROJECTS MOODLE
